



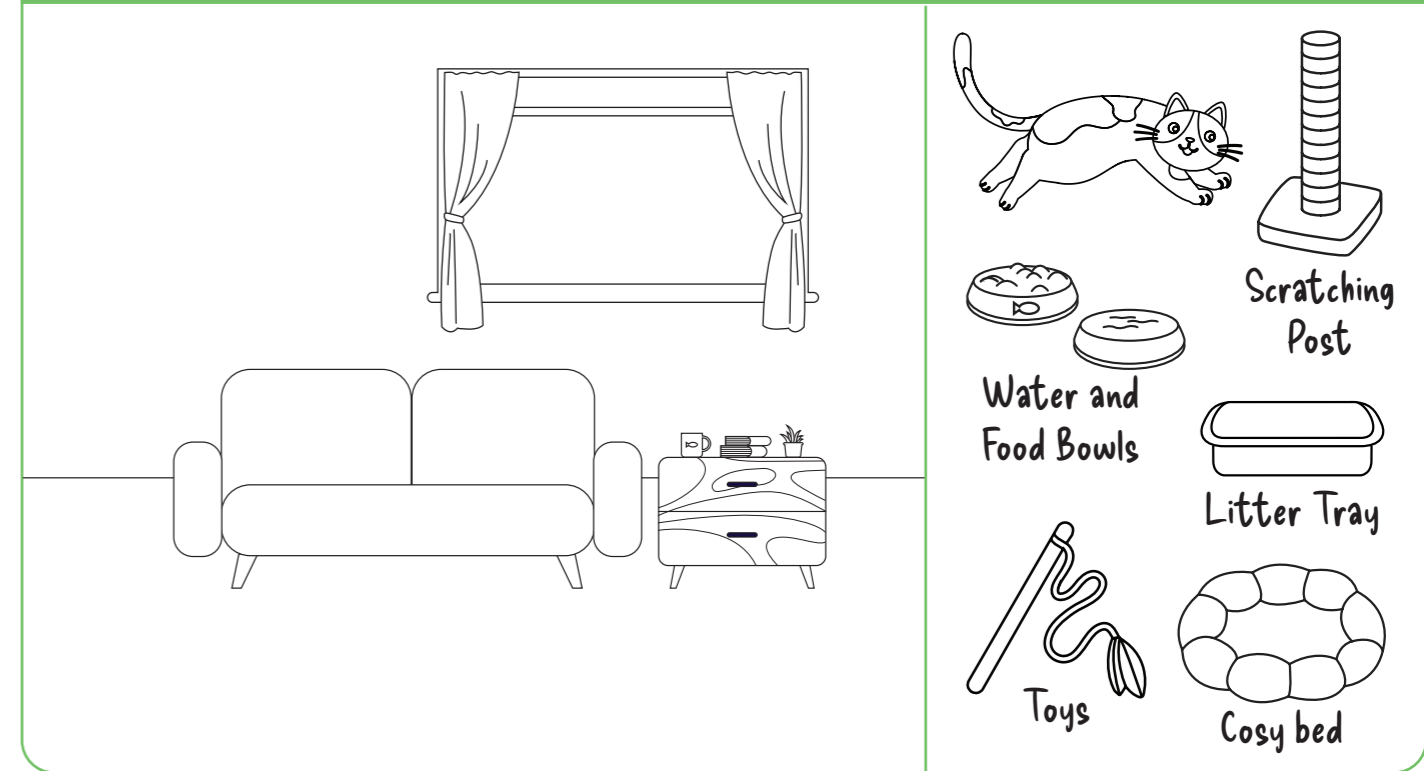
## ACTIVITY 1: FIND-A-CAT
